### First - The Answers to Quiz Number 3

- (1) According to the Bible, which king of Israel wrote many of the Psalms? **King David.**
- (2) Where in the Bible is the 'Our Father'? **Matthew's Gospel, chapter 6, also Luke's Gospel, chapter 11.**
- (3) Which Old Testament prophet was told by God 'before I formed you in the womb, I knew you and consecrated you'? **Jeremiah. The quote comes from Jeremiah chapter 1.**
- (4) The National Shrine to Our Lady of Walsingham is in which English county? **Norfolk.**
- (5) Where is the Diocesan Shrine of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour? **Great Billing, Northampton.**
- (6) How is a crucifix different from a cross? **A crucifix is a cross which includes an image of the crucified Christ on it.**
- (7) What does the word 'genuflect' mean? **It means to kneel briefly on one knee. When in church, it is normal to genuflect towards the tabernacle as a mark of respect to the Blessed Sacrament.**
- (8) What is a monstrance? **A monstrance is the ornamental stand used to display the Blessed Sacrament for Adoration or Benediction.**
- (9) The Belgian priest Fr. Georges Lemaitre was responsible for which important scientific achievement? **He was a physicist who studied the expansion of the Universe and was the first scientist to formulate the Big Bang theory.**
- (10) A crucifix often has the letters I.N.R.I. on the top arm of the cross. What do these letters mean? **They stand for "Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudeorum", which is Latin for "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews". This represents the sign which Pontius Pilate ordered to be put on Jesus' cross to declare who he was (described in John 19:19-22).**
