### First - The Answers to Quiz Number 4

- (1) Which Old Testament prophet foresaw Jesus as, 'A man of sorrows, familiar with suffering'?  
Isaiah. The quote is from Isaiah chapter 53, which is generally read in church on Good Friday.
- (2) Who told Pontius Pilate, 'Have nothing to do with that man' when Jesus was brought before him for trial? Pilate's wife, who had been troubled by a dream about Jesus and recognized him as a 'righteous man' [Matt 27:19].
- (3) Where does the Bible talk about the Anointing of the Sick? The Letter of St James 5:13-15.
- (4) What is the final word in the Bible? Amen.
- (5) St Theodore was an Archbishop of Canterbury in the 7th century AD. But he was not an Englishman. Where was he from? He was from Tarsus, in an area that is now a part of Turkey.
- (6) Which English author, best known for his children's books about Narnia, also wrote popular Christian books including 'Mere Christianity', 'The Screwtape Letters' and 'The Great Divorce'? C.S. Lewis.
- (7) The body of which saint is displayed in a glass reliquary in Westminster Cathedral? St John Southworth.
- (8) Which nationality was Mother Teresa (St Teresa of Calcutta)? She was Albanian.
- (9) What does the Lourdes Medical Bureau do? It investigates cases where pilgrims to Lourdes have reported healings, to assess which cases are medically inexplicable and may be miraculous.
- (10) How many beads are there on a set of rosary beads? 59, not counting the crucifix and the centre-piece.
